WP 5 - Demonstration, Dissemination and Exploitation

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Abstract

This document accompanies the first Deliverable of WP5T2 *Demonstration workshops and events*. EMIL Lighthouse projects, selected FSTPs and associated topics will be continuously demonstrated at physical and virtual workshops, events and conferences like FMX, Aurea Award, CVMP, Sonar and others. Industry experts will get the opportunity to engage with FSTP innovative minds and entrepreneurship paving the way to commercialization. Workshops and events will be utilized to extend and strengthen the EMIL network.

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1 Background

EMIL has from its outset been designed as an open network that goes beyond providing financial funding through Financial Support to Third Parties (FSTP). In order to achieve a pan-European community of key XR industry/creators/researchers, the design of EMIL is intended to build a strong network by way of adding mentoring, node allocation, provision of infrastructures and tutoring to the financial support. Furthermore, the four partners' Lighthouse Projects are offered as accompanying and ongoing demonstrators of XR's potential that the FSTP projects and other interested parties can employ as starting points for collaboration and exchange. Finally, EMIL itself is continuously hosting networking and dissemination events to build the EMIL community, as well as presenting the EMIL project at international conferences and other networking events. All these dissemination activities therefore aim not only at advertising the funding opportunities of EMIL but at creating a network that can be useful for all partners and the FSTP projects in order to disseminate their respective projects.

2 Introduction

EMIL has undertaken a number of dissemination activities up until now. These can mainly be described as PR activities, networking through online websites and social media publications, partaking in workshops, events and conferences and presenting EMIL or individual EMIL partners' research and Lighthouse Projects as well as print publications and attendance of events both online and physical.

3 Website and Social Media

The EMIL website (https://emil-xr.eu) and its social media accounts on the platforms LinkedIn (https://www.linkedin.com/company/emil-xr), Facebook (https://www.linkedin.com/company/emil-xr), Facebook (https://www.goutube.com/@EMIL-XR) are EMIL's main online dissemination tools. EMIL uses the website and the different platforms with individual content to promote EMIL as a project, community building, the FSTP calls and the FSTP funded projects as well as the Lighthouse projects, to inform about ongoing activities such as dissemination at workshops, conferences and other events, and to retain an online audience, i.e. website visitors and social media followers posted on current status updates. For a detailed description of the setup of these platforms see also EMIL's deliverable D5.2 (which is available publicly on the EMIL website).




Figure 1 Website Visitors

At the time of writing of this deliverable, EMIL Call 2 has been closed. Looking at the statistics of the website shows a steady interest in EMIL with obvious peaks in the weeks before the two call submission deadlines. On average the website attracted more than 200 visitors daily while

significantly more have visited during submission times (peak was 1200 daily visitors). A weekly posting scheme on all platforms has been established. Total page views have been 55,000 as of writing this deliverable. Aside from Google.com as the most popular search engine, our Social Media channels have brought the most visitors to the website, underlining the success of our social media activities.

On LinkedIn a total of 694 people are actively following the EMIL project. The page itself (not the individual posts) got 2133 page views. Usual posts are generating 200 – 700 impressions. While at the same time paid promoted posts have been very effective as they have reached more than 43,000 views.




Figure 3 LinkedIn page views per month (solid: desktop, dashed: mobile)

- and the "Recognition of 12 European projects of the UPF-DTIC" including EMIL.




Figure 17 Presentation of the new UPF Center for Studies in Artificial and Natural Intelligence (CeSANI). UPF, DTIC, June 2023.




Figure 18 EMIL at Digital Summit - Economy 4.0 Baden-Württemberg

6 EMIL Network

During the Q2 and Q3 of 2023 the EMIL consortium realized a growing number of outreach activities unrelated to potential FSTP submissions.
